- (2) The documents contain facts or statements that might threaten the safety of or endanger the life or safety of individuals;
- (3) It is necessary to preserve the right to a fair trial;
- (4) Disclosure would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; and
- (5) Production of such records would disclose investigative techniques and procedures.

After due consideration and with good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the record herein shall be disclosed except for the following:

- 1. Exhibit A and B attached to the Stipulation to Release Property are SEALED.
- 2. The Stipulation to Release Property and Order to Release Property be REDACTED.
- 3. This order will remain in effect until further order of the court.
