>> Somebody's always live. M you gangster, too. For I saw you, too, when you went to that house. You troop. I like that.

>> I just walked by. Check it out.

>> Yeah, I like I like your style. I'm down with it. You got

>> All right. Sweet.

>> Appreciate that.

>> That's not

sit right here. But but I'm not sure that dude is uh around here. I think he's in in Tucson.

>> Listen, I'm not surprised. I wouldn't be surprised. He's a real real weird.

Couple weirdos.

>> I think his brother was in a chat. I screenshotted a bunch of his comments.

He said his brother was in Puma County camping at some place.

>> Hold up, guys. Sorry to interrupt. Look who showed up.

>> I just randomly came over.

>> Hey, Jacob.

>> TG Hill.

>> What up? What up?

>> What's this?

>> Gone live.

>> Yeah, I told him to sit there because then they'd be like, "Who the [__] is sitting in this chair? Is that Is that Jacob?"

there is at every Walmart at every uh
what do you call it online? You think
that the word those are the only two
three ski masks in this in the city?

>> Shocking. It's shocking,

>> right? I mean that so so let me let me
just get this straight. Let me just get
this straight. So So

So they sell guns everywhere

>> in the United States.

>> If I if I shoot somebody and I have a
gun

because they sell them everywhere,

>> bro.

Come on, man.

>> Come on, bro.

>> You're gone. I don't have time for that.

I got I got stars here, man. I don't
need to listen to that [__] I got

>> logic went right out the window. Yeah, I
know. So, what do you have there,
Sleuth?

>> Anything new in the case? Did you see
the cops tried to trample on my right
last night?

>> Yeah, you might have a case there,
buddy.

>> Yeah, I mean,

>> have you sat down with an attorney yet?
You might have a case there.

>> I was looking into it. Me, man, I'm more

worried about Nancy, bro. Like, I get it. I get it. And And I'm

>> Yeah, but that's the problem. They're trying to stop people from from bringing attention to Nancy. And if they keep us from going out there, it's awesome.

>> Stand my ground, I'm going be out there tomorrow all day. So if that Hines Hannes guy wants to come out there and tell me the same thing again,

>> he's going to have to arrest me or give me a ticket because I'm allowed to be there. And those signs are invalid. 100% invalid.

>> You mean the guy that want to shake hand, but he went to the neighbor and shook their hand?

>> Yeah.

>> Jacob, when he does that to every officer he goes to, he he introduces himself, they shake their hand. Him, he's like, "I don't want to shake your hand." But then around the corner when he told those people to move the cars to park them in the driveway, he was out there shaking their hand.

>> That wasn't a standard uh sheriff, right?

>> And I think the point

>> I think the point of wearing the ski mask is to make people uncomfortable.

>> Exactly. Because that's exactly what

that should have happened on February 1st. The neighbors should have been uncomfortable and more diligent more vigilant in and looking around the neighborhood. I agree. Well, who's it making feel uncomfortable? The people who lost this lady.

>> I mean, let's real the the family was the last person to see her. So, that means they're the per people who lost this woman. They don't know where she's at. Okay.

>> So, are we supposed to be feeling sorry for them? The people, the actual people that lost this lady.

>> I mean, make it make sense, >> you know? And remember, they were the first ones at the crime scene. And don't forget, not only were they the first ones at the crime scene, they're the ones who started the narrative, okay? They're in control of the narrative.

>> How do you know guy's not inside the house? How do you know? You know, she didn't show up where she's supposed to be. walked up her her doors are propped open. I wouldn't first think a ambulance left the door,

>> right? That's weird to know.

>> They're going to suggest

>> Yeah, but if if you do something really weird kind of sound like a plausible explain I mean

>> it only takes him 30 seconds to check on the radio.

>> I mean, I don't think it would take you very long to figure out that's not what happened. But

>> you don't get to redo it, right? You don't get to redo the discovery of this uh crime scene, right? You don't get to go back and go, "Oh man, I should have done this. I should have done that." Cuz it's in real time. You're not thinking there's some ski mask video just waiting to be discovered, you know, through an FBI search warrant.

>> But there was blood inside the house.

>> So, how would they have not called?

>> What is the What is the first thing that everybody says? Blood thinners. Blood thinners. Remember,

>> that's everybody that's all they talked about. Blood thinners. Blood thinners.

>> Oh, that's right. That's right. That's why you're on this side. Yeah, you're right. That's the only reason

>> that you kind of smell. I'm just kidding.

>> So, I I'll send you this.

>> This doesn't count as um camping either.

>> What doing?

>> No covering,

>> no bedding, no tents, no stoves.

>> Well, I got a I got a pop-up tent supposed to be here tomorrow, I think.

>> That then could definitely be considered camping.

>> Camping? No, it's a pop. Like you just lift it up and it you could go inside and pee in a bottle because the the problem with peeing in public is you why you can't pee on an piss on an easement is because you're exposing yourself.

>> Here, let me read this.

>> Uh the city of Tucson strictly prohibits establishing temporary campsites, >> including the use of tents, bedding, shade structures, or stoves on public rights of way. So that would be considered a tent.

>> But listen, you also put it away when you're done peeing. So it's not like something we're just going to leave out there. You know what I'm saying?

>> It's also Puma County, not Tucson.

>> Yeah, it's Pima County. But still, in other words, we're not going to just leave it. They're like, "Hey, everybody need a piss."

>> Yeah. Anybody go in there, take a piss from there.

>> But maybe it is not, you know, because every time I looked it up, they're like, "You have to get to find like a wall that's not

>> Why are they so bound? Why are they so bound to determine to keep people out of that area

>> in the

>> first place?

>> This is their argument. I think they're trying to make a case that you're blocking the right way. But in all actuality, the the they Puma County or the property owner, I think, needs to clear that easement up to I think at

least four to six feet.

>> Oh, I see what

>> from the road.

>> Yes. Or you have no other choice. You know what I mean?

Have you looked at the count uh Puma County law?

>> Otherwise, everybody that's walking their dog would be under arrest.

>> Mhm. Jaywalking.

>> The guy that got busted for the weed.

>> He had a picture of Nancy. Oh,

>> sexual harassment.

>> I know her. I know her. Who?

This Travis guy, he sexually harassed a young woman.

>> Yeah. No,

>> kidnapping was there, too.

>> Like, why you have to ask yourself, why is this making me feel uncomfortable?

>> Exactly. That's 100% the truth, bro.

>> But he didn't tell me that he went on a freaking 30 minute long rant. It's It's okay, Alex. You know what? I don't care.

I don't care. But I'm not going to go on a live stream and bash you for 30 [__] minutes. You're my friend.

You're a fellow YouTuber. You're not a fellow YouTuber or something like that.

>> When you go public on a live stream, that's when it changes.

>> Thank you.

>> It's when you're publicly. Now, I understand we got trolls in the chat. We got people that can't talk [__] about us. But when you're another YouTuber that we have respected and we have shouted you out and you go on a live

stream for 30 freaking minutes straight
and you do that, that's the utmost
disrespect. Look, I get it. You might
not like it. You don't have to like it.
Don't go on a damn live stream running
other YouTubers names in the dirt.

>> Yeah,

>> that's

>> He should He should have stopped at I
wouldn't have done that.

>> That's

And that's respectful. That's a
respectable. Yeah,

>> I wouldn't have done it either because I
don't like the damn mask. What's up,
Don?

>> That's where it should have that's where
it should have ended. Right there. I
wouldn't have done

>> Yeah, but I mean, at the end of the day,
does the mask really matter?

>> I mean,

>> right.

>> Here, here's my take. My mom's 80 years
old. If my mom went missing, I would
roll my smokers out to the street. I'm
my grills. I'd be cooking for everybody
that's there. I wouldn't give a [__] if
you guys swapped spit and pissed in each
other's boots. Who cares? You're
bringing attention to my mom.

They want the attention because when those things get out there, you're lighting a fire under law enforcement's ass. That's

>> right? 112 days later. Like that's kind of I think what irritates people is just

seeing the family not doing anything
about it where

>> do they have answers that we don't or
you know what I mean?

>> The streamers also bring uh the family
right there. You know, when they want to
check in on things and hear what's going
on, they all they have to do is tune
into these people streaming. They're
right there at their their own home
where they grew up.

>> They're hearing all the information
surrounding the case and then they can
bounce.

>> But it's a window right there into
things.

>> Yeah. I was watching the night with the
mask.

>> JLR took the mask. JLR took the mask as

>> Wait easier

>> and wait earlier if you just gave the public the actual information to be able to help.

>> Couple press conferences might be nice.

>> I cannot give information.
press conference.

>> Okay, tell us this.

>> That's That is the whole press conference. I cannot get that. That is the whole press conference,

>> right?

>> Did you hand the case over to the FBI?

>> The FBI is also [__] cops and they also suck.

>> I cannot discuss

>> that. They're not going to do anything either.

Now, the other thing is too, did you see the license plate cameras I I sent you?

>> Which ones?

>> Yeah, they're

>> DGL.

>> Oh, yeah. Yeah, DGL. Someone's asking.

>> Yeah.

>> Remember the blue car? DGL? The blue car that was was freaking you out?

>> I do because I've seen the blue car like for two or three weeks straight before he got this DUI and he disappeared.

>> That's the same guy that was the two backpack guy. It's the same guy.

>> continue to work it. They're not they're not doing that. They're not going to do that. They never do that. They just do what they do, which is you do a little bit of work initially and then you [__] off. Like you sit in your your your squad car and just sit there and you're not doing any work.
